



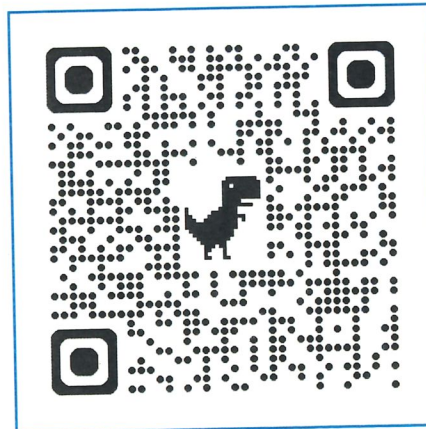

Aquifer Water Quality Assessment for Kansas (AWQUA)

Do you want to know about the quality of your water well? The KGS AWQUA program is looking for volunteer wells to measure baseline chemistry data across the state. Wells are sampled every other year by a KGS representative. Samples are analyzed for nitrate, chloride, manganese, arsenic, selenium, uranium, carbon, pH, and other water quality parameters. Results will be mailed or emailed to owners and will be displayed in a database on the KGS website. Owner names and addresses will not be displayed.

A KGS representative will come collect the sample, and testing will come at no cost to the well owner.
