## Water Well Application

A complete description of the requirements for construction of water wells may be found in the Reno County Sanitation Code.

## Minimum Setbacks for Water Wells\*

- Property line or public right of way -25'
   (Road right-of-way may not be included)
- Contamination Source -50'
   Contamination sources include sewer lines, pressure lines, septic tank, laterals, pit privy, seepage pits, fertilizer storage, pesticide storage, feed lots or barn yard, and other wastewater systems.

Following information verified by applicant below:

- Watertight sewer line -10'
- Surface Water 50'
- Pump pit 2'
